All BSC Adult Rec. League Players Agree to:

- To respect all game officials, opponent players, teammates and fans at all times before, during or after a match, even at later times away from the field of play.
- Have a basic understanding of the FIFA Laws of the Game and understand and abide by the modified BSC Adult Rec. League rules.
- Teams are responsible for the conduct of their fans. The game official or a BSC representative has the authority to remove a fan from the fields.
- Any verbal statement and or physical violence to game officials, teammates, opponent players or fans will result in a disciplinary action against the parties involved and could result in banning the player from continuing with the league.
- Team Captains, players and their fans are responsible for the proper treatment of the facility.
- Abide by the BSC policies of NO PETS, NO ALCOHOL, NO TOBACCO PRODUCTS & NO E-DEVICES for all Club related activities.
- Team Captains are responsible for ensuring that the corner flags are placed prior to the start of the match, and that they are returned to the job box at the end of the match.
- Team Captains are responsible for the team's official game ball. BSC will provide one game ball to each team at the start of the season.
- If any equipment is damaged due to team negligence or failure to follow the BSC code of conduct, the costs to replace the damaged equipment will be passed on to the teams.
- AT NO TIME WILL A GUEST PLAYER BE PERMITTED TO PLAY ON THE FIELD. A PLAYER MUST BE REGISTERED WITH BSC TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LEAGUE. NO EXCEPTIONS.
